- ◆ **Questions by email** Emailed questions from both beekeepers and non-beekeepers are welcome, and will receive personal replies. Be aware that I often travel, so responses may sometimes be delayed. However, I will make every effort to respond promptly to questions which are time dependent, especially those which appear to be emergencies.
- ◆ **Telephone consultations** For more immediate and detailed advice, I offer telephone consultations at a pre-paid fee. Email me for rates or to schedule a call.
- ◆ **Apiary visits** If your situation requires a more hands on approach, I will conduct an apiary visit with you in your hives to advise on a problem or provide one-on-one teaching. The fee will include an hourly rate and travel expenses. I will gladly work with beekeepers or with local organizations to schedule joint or back to back visits in order to reduce costs. Visits are subject to re-scheduling or cancellation in case of inclement weather. Temperatures must be above 60 °F and clear to open hives. Email me for information about my rates and schedule.
- ◆ **Speaking** I am available to speak to both beekeeping and non-beekeeping groups on a wide range of beekeeping topics. I will also conduct beekeeping classes (see below) tailored to the needs of your group. Email me to discuss scheduling my services as a speaker or instructor, and to discuss talk topics, course content, speaking fees, and travel expenses.
- ◆ **Beekeeping classes** In cooperation with the University of Kentucky's Ecological Research and Education Center, I teach courses for both new and experienced beekeepers at their facility in Lexington, Kentucky. Classes for experienced beekeepers are held at various times throughout the year. Beginner classes are in late fall through early spring.
